Jason Leopold is former Los Angeles bureau chief for Dow Jones Newswires. He has written over 2,000 stories on the California energy crisis and received the Dow Jones Journalist of the Year Award in 2001. Leopold also reported extensively on Enron's downfall and was the first journalist to land an interview with former Enron President Jeffrey Skilling following Enron's bankruptcy filing in December 2001.
